- 19 of 28 ROAR Members live in Colorado

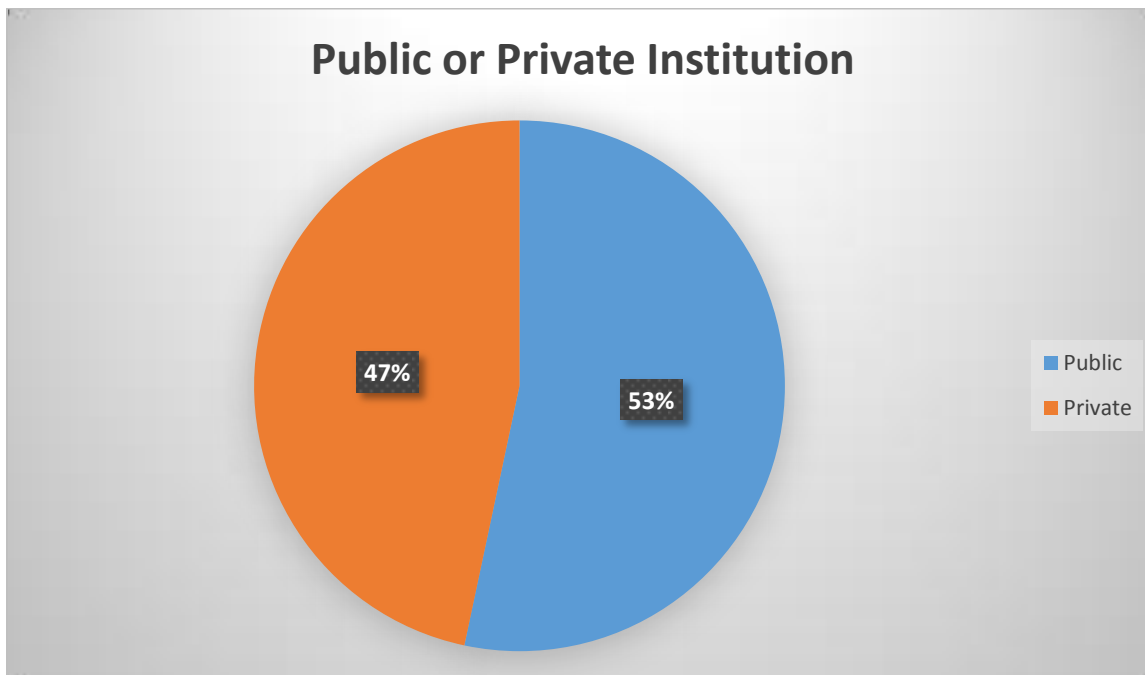
2013-2014 ROAR Events:

- ROAR hosted a table at the Colorado Council Conference in December to promote the brand and create more awareness of the organization.

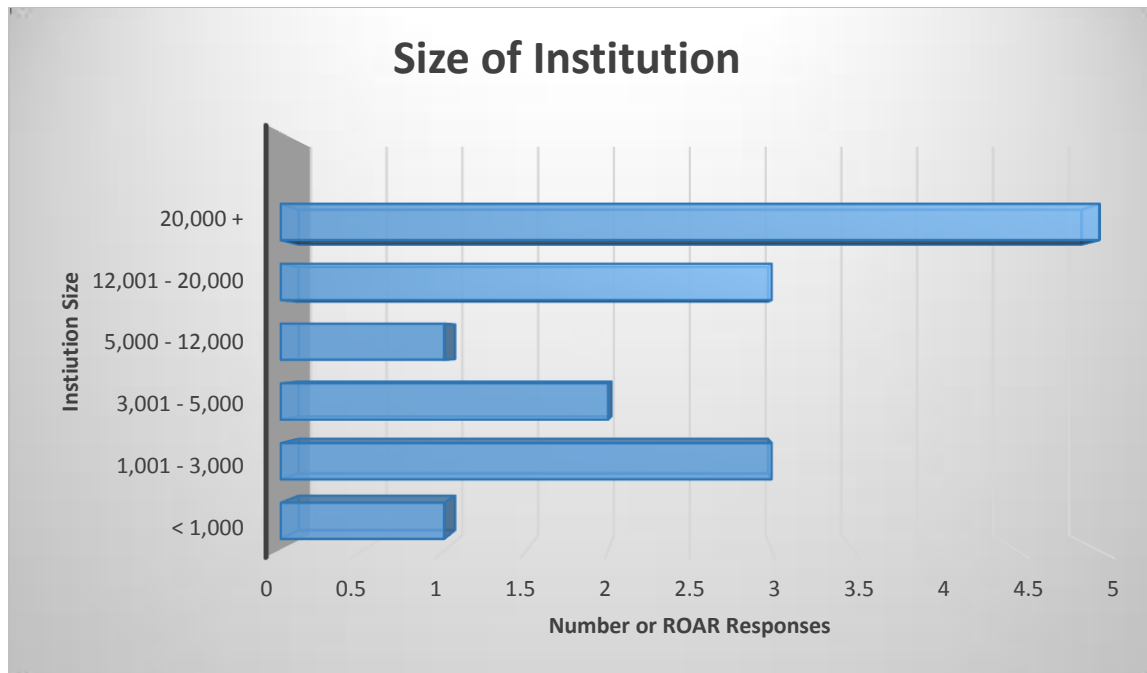

15 respondents to the annual ROAR Report of 27 member schools = 55% of organizations reporting

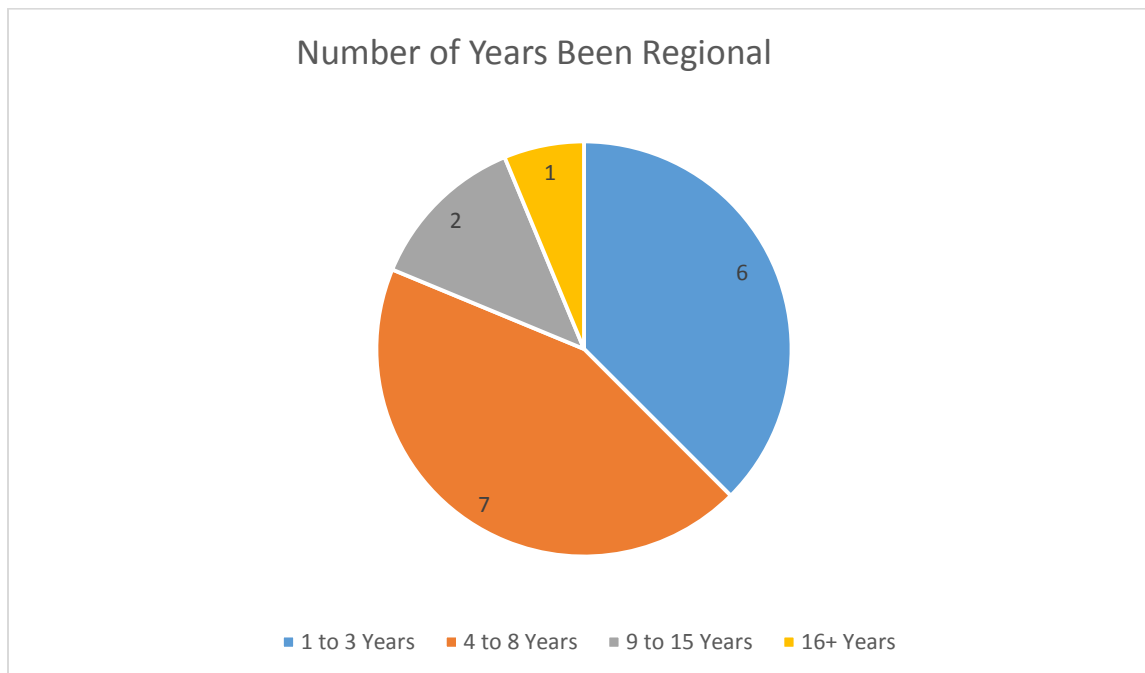
1.) Of respondents - public or private institution:



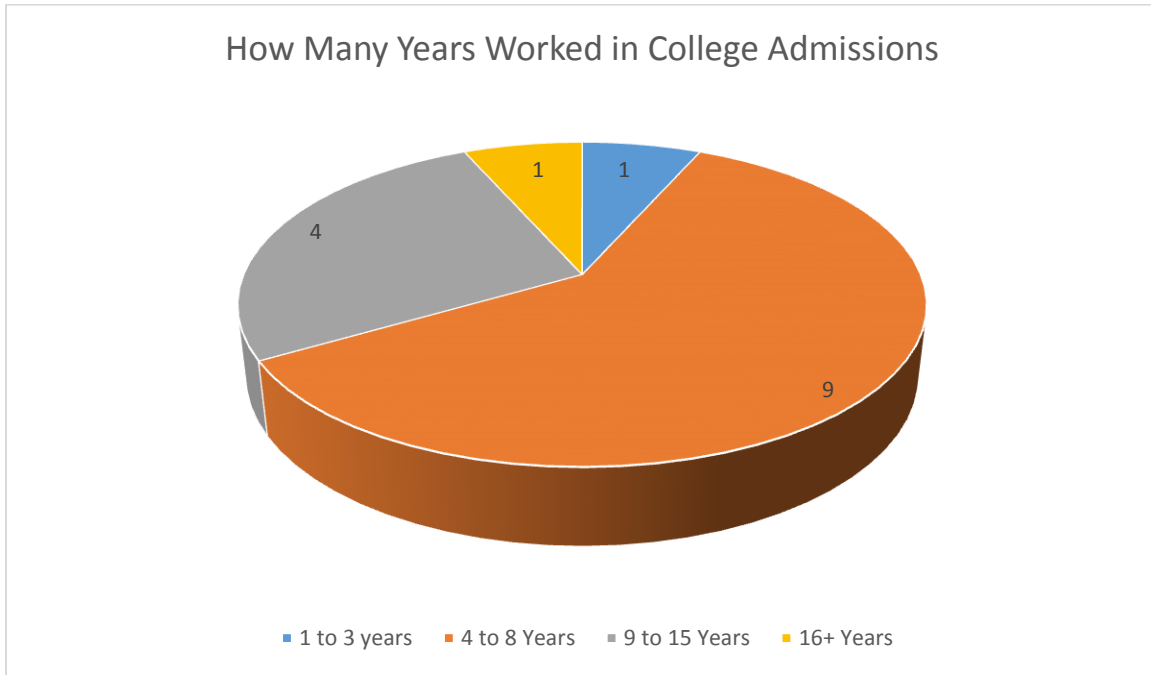
2.) Institution Size



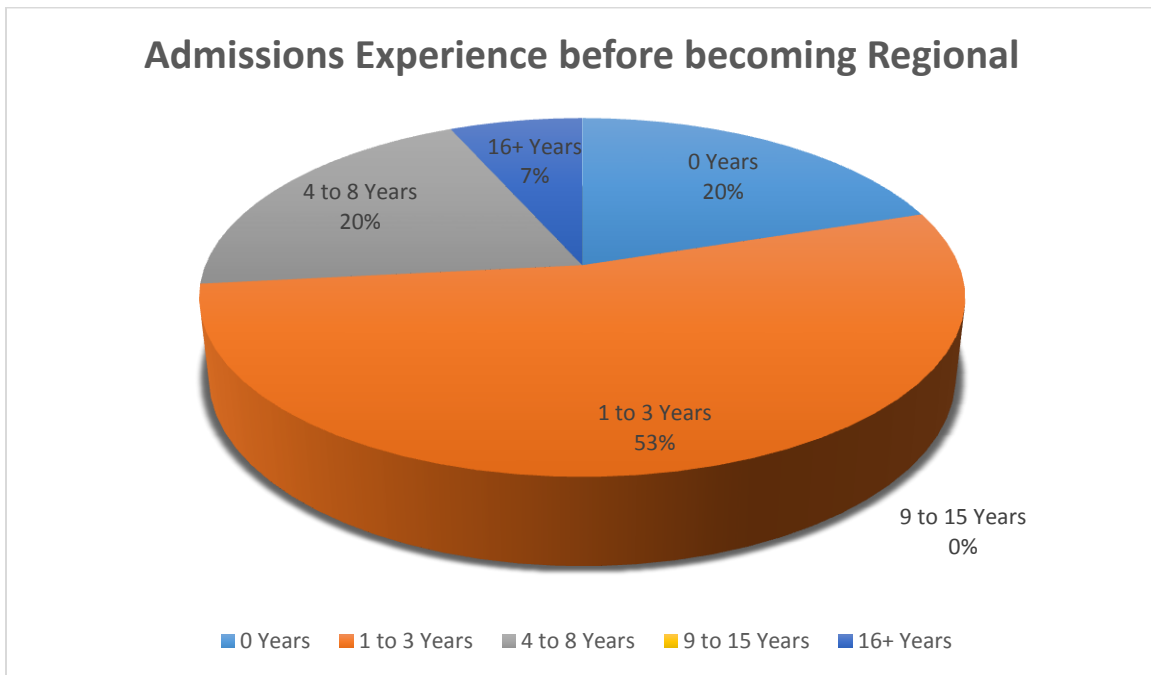
3.) How long have you been a regional representative?



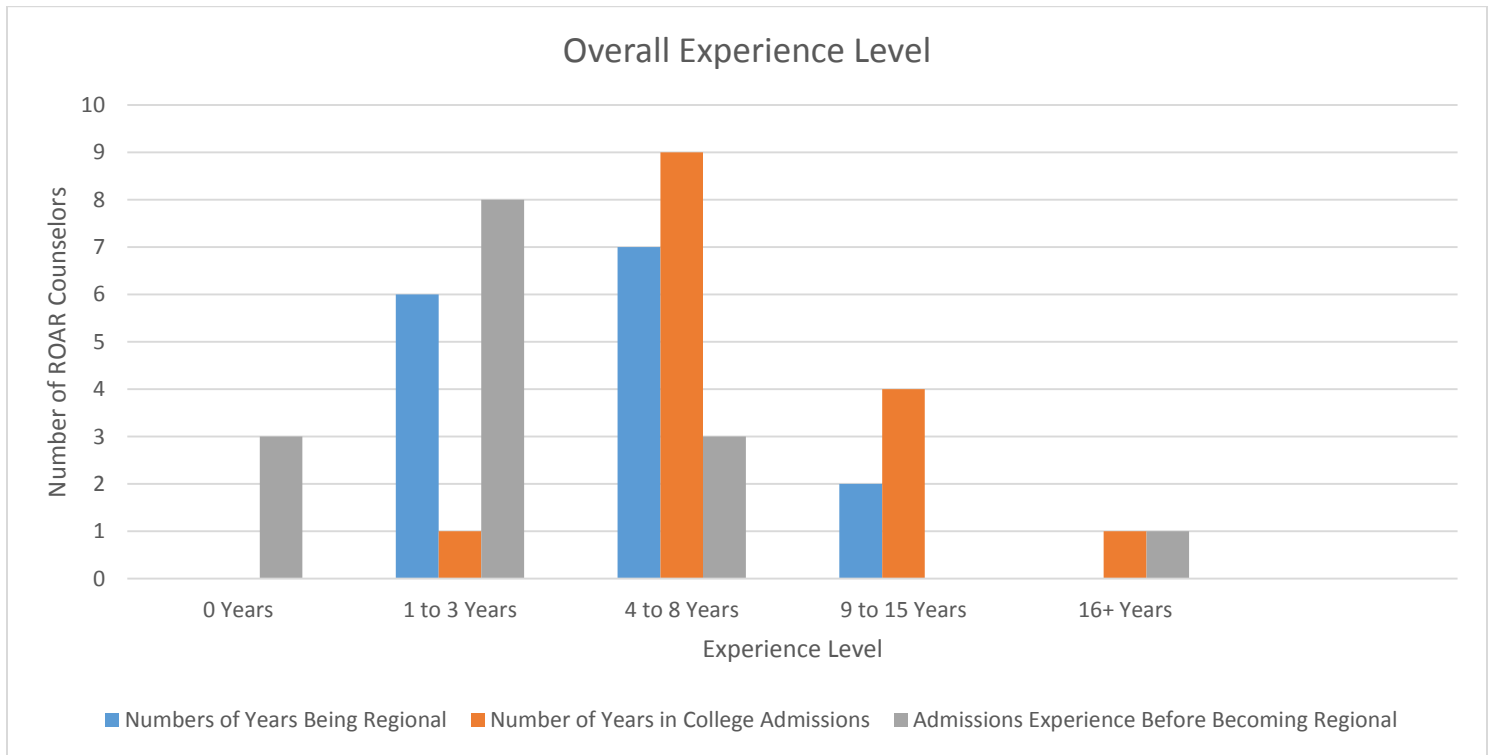
4.) How long have you worked in college admissions?



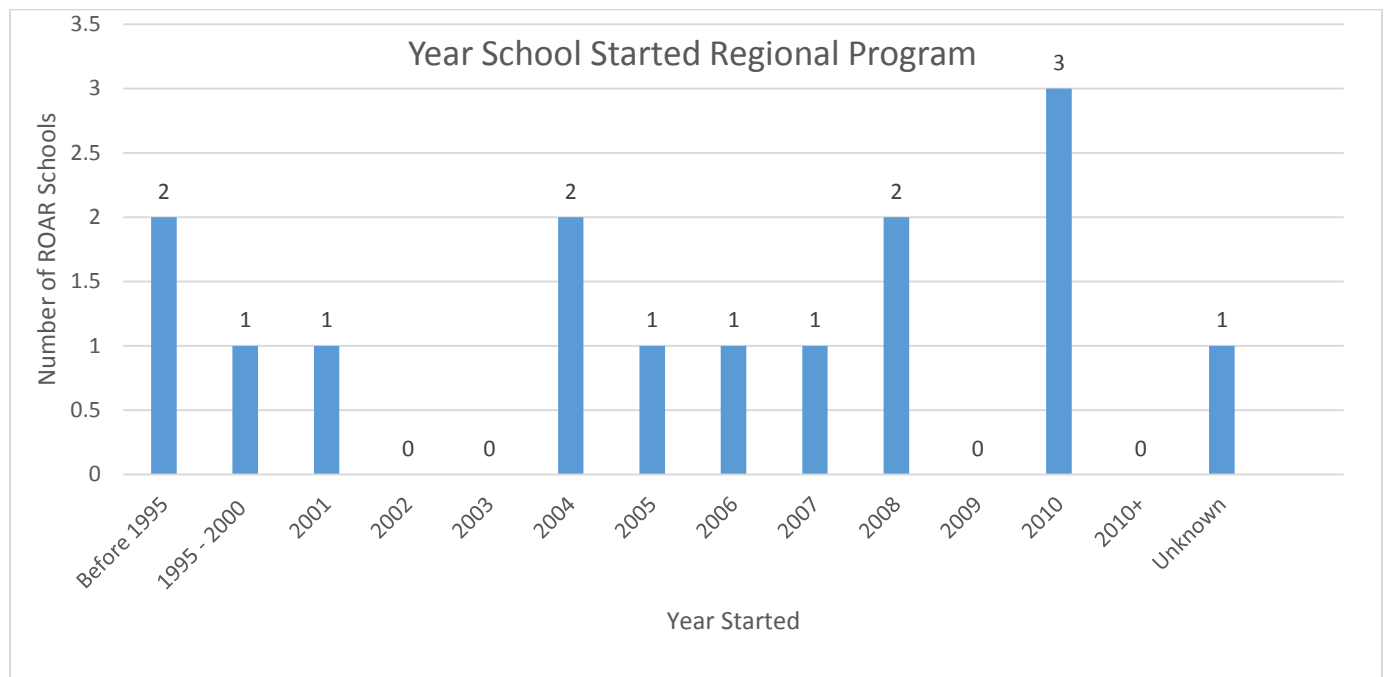
5.) How many years of Admissions experience did you have before becoming regional?



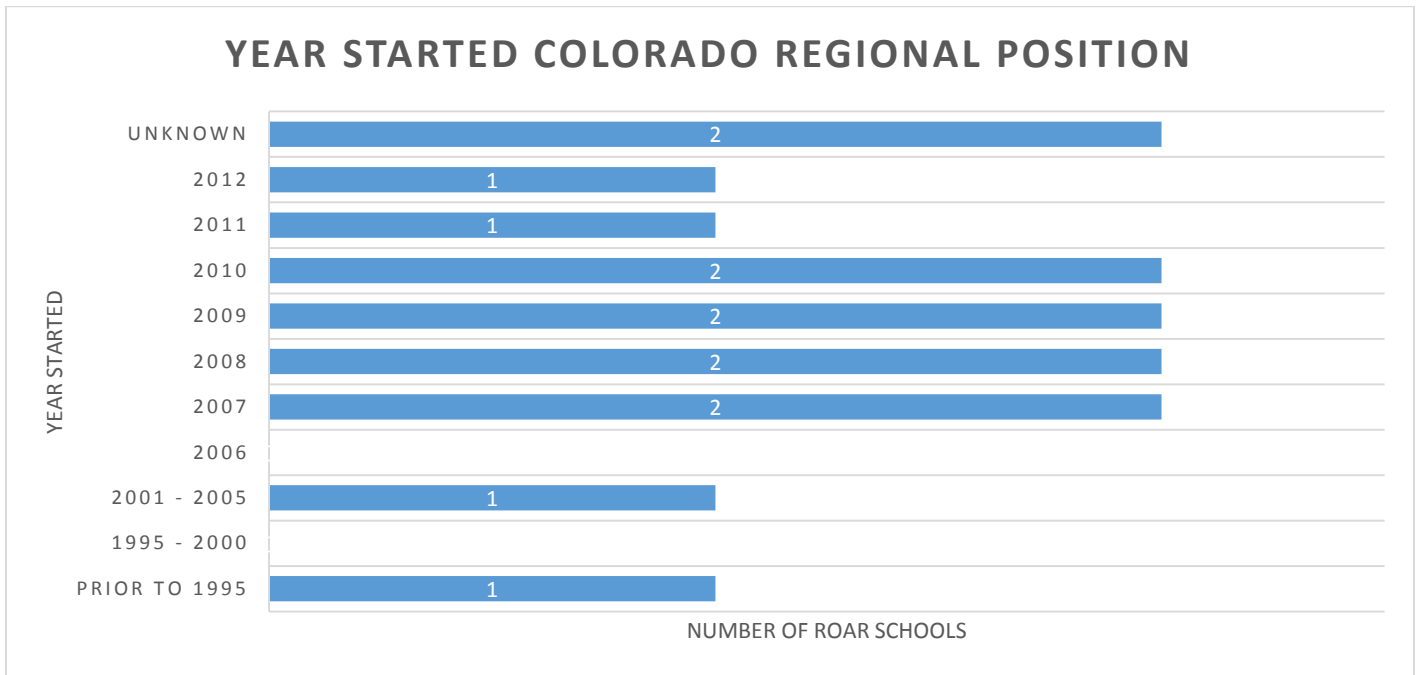

6.) In what year did your school start their regional program?

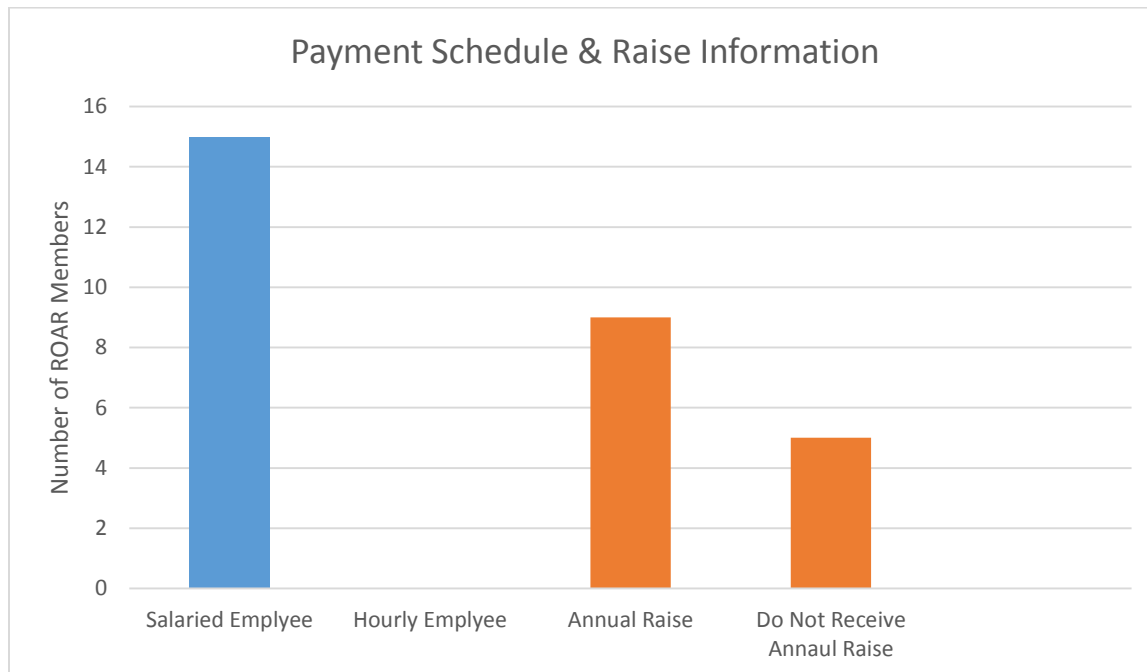


7.) In what year did your school start regional program in Colorado?

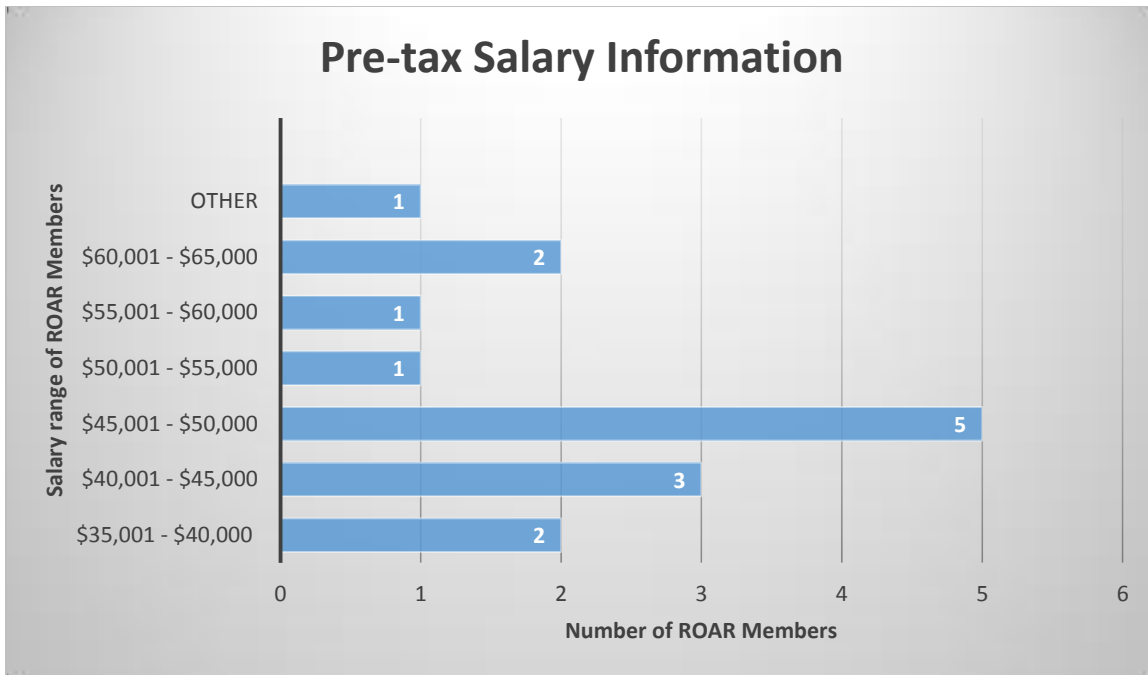


8.) Are you a salaried employee and do you receive annual raises?

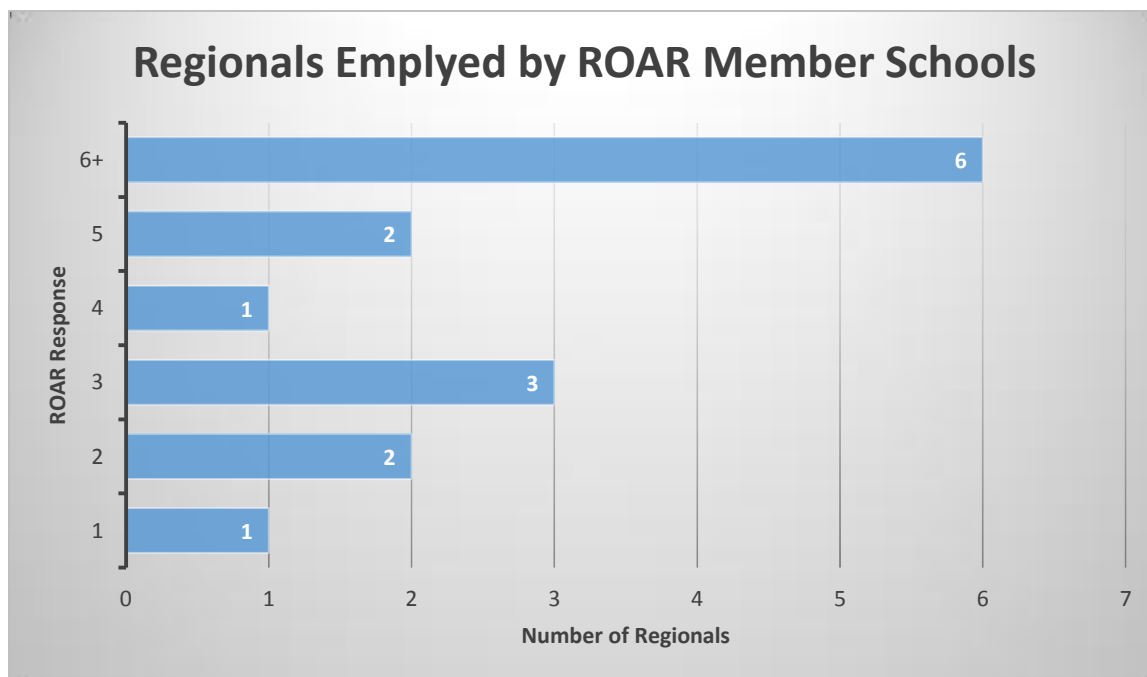
15/15 are salaried. Three selected "yes" they receive annual raises, however indicated it depended on the year, which were include in results as receiving annual raises.



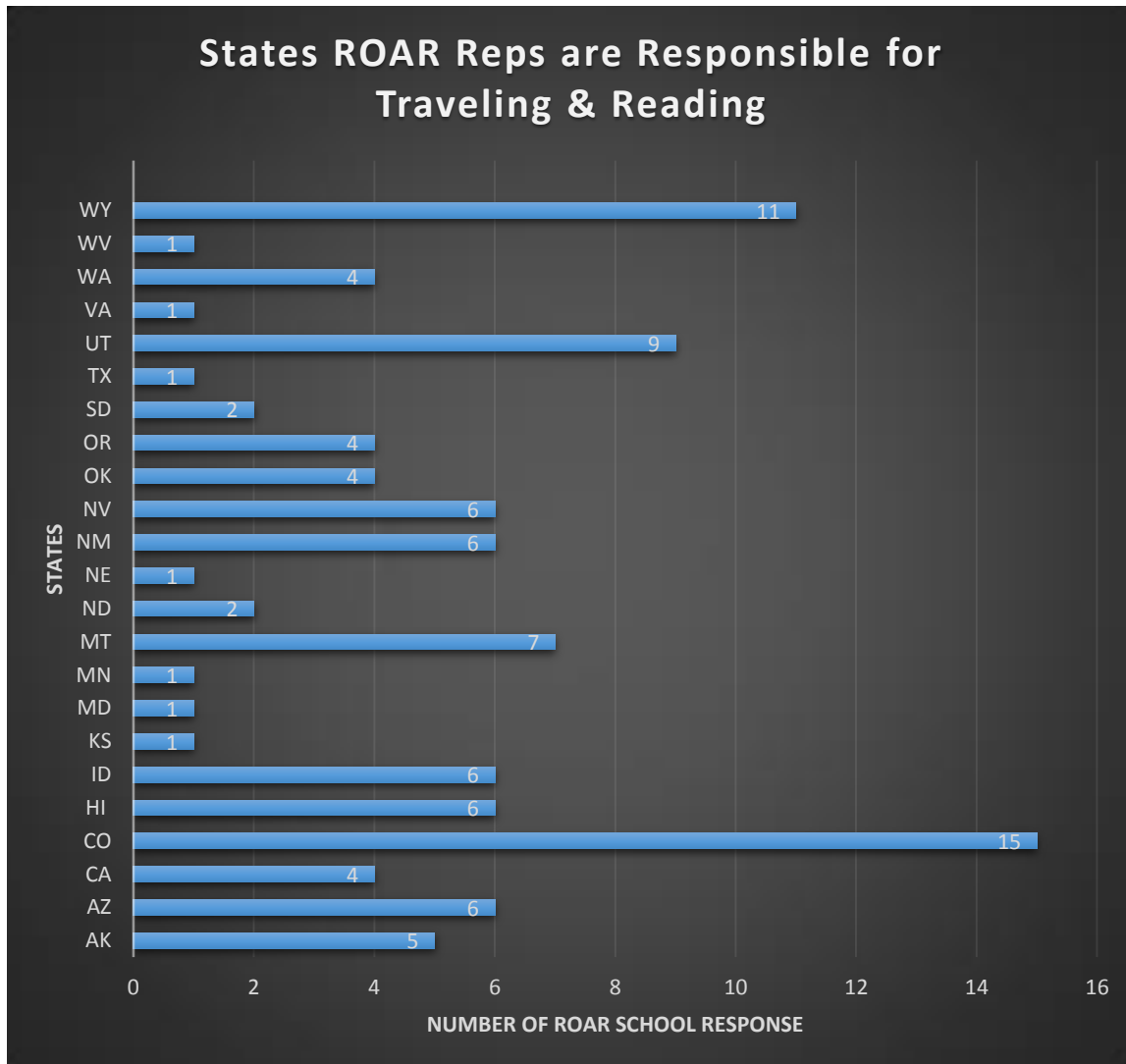
9.) What is your current pay, pre-tax?
